2. Study Break for Primary 6 Clementians from 22 to 24 September (Mon to Wed)

2.1. As communicated via the Parents Gateway (PG) on 1 September, the Ministry of Education will be implementing a study break for Primary 6 students from 22 to 24 September (Mon to Wed) to support their well-being prior to the PSLE.

2.2. During the study break, P6 Clementians are strongly encouraged to remain at home and do their revision. Clementians who require assistance from their teachers may arrange for consultations with their teachers in school. In addition, the school may request selected Clementians to return to school during the study break. A PG notification will be sent out to the Clementians who have been selected to return to school during the study break. The school will remain open for P6 Clementians who require in-school support.

2.3. Parents/guardians who are unable to secure alternative care arrangements may also approach the school for assistance. The Student Care Centre in school will remain open in the afternoons for families who require the service.

3. Showing Appreciation to Our Staff

3.2. Your words of appreciation will go a long way in motivating our staff to continue giving their best to our Clementians.

4. Smoking Outside School Compound

4.1. We would like to highlight that smoking is prohibited by law within 5 metres of the school compound. We seek your cooperation in ensuring that this regulation is followed at all times. Maintaining a smoke-free environment around the school is essential for the health and well-being of our students, staff, and visitors.

5. School Gate Policy

5.1. We refer to the revised school gate policy that was implemented with effect from Term 3 this year, communicated via the Term 3 Parent Notification dated 26 June 2025. To summarize, we had observed that some Clementians had been running across the school driveway in a hazardous manner to reach their parents' cars after CCA and remedial sessions. To prevent accidents and to ensure everyone's safety, the school piloted the arrangement where parents were disallowed to park in the school premises while waiting to pick up their children after dismissals from after-school programmes. Parents were advised to use the nearby public carpark.

5.2. The school had piloted the revised arrangement for Term 3, with modifications to address the implementation issues. A review had been conducted, taking into consideration our observations and feedback from our stakeholders. We would like to thank parents who had actively provided us with your feedback.

5.3. With effect from Term 4, we will modify the arrangement from 2 pm onwards after school dismissal:

- Vehicles will be permitted to enter the school premises for pick-up purposes
- 2 parking lots will be reserved for parents, with waiting time of up to 5 minutes
- Due to space constraints in view of the school's small parking area and short driveway, parents are to "pick-and-go"
- If your child is not at the foyer when you arrive, and the 2 parking lots are occupied, we seek your understanding to park at the nearby public carpark and walk over to the school to fetch your child (public car parks near Clementi Primary School include the one at Blk 435 Clementi Ave 3, the car park at Clementi Cascadia, and the HDB carpark at The Clementi Mall).


2 Parking Lots Reserved for Parents:
