Dear Parents/Guardians,

I hope you had time during this September school break to bond and recharge with your child/ward. As we begin our last school term of the year, I would like to keep you informed of the important dates in Term 4.

1. Important Dates for Term 4

12-14 October (Mon to Wed)	PSLE Marking Exercise	All Clementians are not required to be in school except for P3 classes coming back for P3 Oral examination. <i>(refer to information about P3 Oral sent out on Parent's Gateway on 19 Aug)</i>
6 November (Fri)	ECG Forum	Details for P6 Clementians will be shared at a later date. Lessons as per normal for P1 to P5 Clementians.
9 November (Mon)	Deepavali	Public Holiday
10 November (Tue)	Admin Day	All Clementians are not required to be in school.
12 November (Thu)	Deepavali Celebration	All Clementians are encouraged to come in their traditional costume / ethnic costume / going-out attire and white school shoes.
18 November (Wed)	P6 Graduation Concert	Details for P6 Clementians will be shared at a later date. Lessons as per normal for P1 to P5 Clementians.
20 November (Fri)	Year-end Child-Teacher-Parent (CTP) Conference	Details will be shared at a later date.
	P1 Orientation for 2027 intake	All Clementians are not required to be in school except for lower primary Clementians who are running the event. Details will be shared at a later date.

(b) Examination Dates

You can find the examination dates in the table below. The Year-End Assessment (YEA) schedules for Primary Three to Primary Five were issued via PG App and uploaded on school website on 19 July 2026.

i. 16 and 17 September (Wed and Thu)	P4 Oral Examinations (after school) Your child will take EL and MTL on either 16 Sep or 17 Sep, as advised by your child's Form Teachers. <i>(Refer to P4 YEA Schedule)</i>
ii. 21 and 22 September (Mon and Tue)	P5 Oral Examinations (after school) Your child will take EL and MTL on either 21 or 22 Sep, as advised by your child's Form Teachers.
iii. 12 and 13 October (Mon and Tue)	P3 Oral Examinations (during PSLE Marking Days 1 and 2) Your child will take EL and MTL on either 12 or 13 Oct as advised by your child's Form Teachers. <i>(Refer to P3 YEA Schedule)</i>

We would appreciate it if you could make the necessary childcare and transport arrangements if your child is taking the oral examinations indicated in **(b)i to (b)iii**. Do contact the General Office at 6779 7449 if you have further queries.

As the school aims to optimise curriculum time and encourage a culture of continuous learning instead of learning just for the examinations, lessons will resume after the Year-End Assessment. During the said period, the remaining topics (if any) for the year will be taught and Clementians will be assessed on their learning before school closes for the year-end holidays. The topics (if any) covered during that period will be included in next year's assessment to ensure that Clementians continue to revise what they had learnt in the previous year.

2. Study Break for Primary 6 Clementians from 21 to 23 September

As communicated via the Parents Gateway (PG) on 28 August, the Ministry of Education will be implementing a study break for Primary 6 students from 21 to 23 September to support their well-being prior to the PSLE.

During the study break, P6 Clementians are strongly encouraged to remain at home and do their revision. Clementians who require assistance from their teachers may arrange for consultations with their teachers in school. In addition, the school may request selected Clementians to return to school during the study break. A PG notification will be sent out to them. The school will remain open for P6 Clementians who require in-school support.

Parents/guardians who are unable to secure alternative care arrangements may also approach the school for assistance. The Student Care Centre in school will remain open in the afternoons for families who require the service.
