## Children's Day Celebrations 2021 (Postponed to Friday, 12 November 2021)

A poll was conducted with Clementians during the recent Home-based Learning, and a large majority of them have indicated their voices to postpone the Children's Day Celebrations as a post-examination activity instead of an online celebration on 7 October. As such, the school will celebrate Children's Day on Friday, 12 November in adherence to the prevailing safe management measures.

The theme for this year's celebrations is 'Rethinking Possibilities' and on this day, Clementians are to come in their 'going out' clothes and covered shoes. The school has engaged Terra Singapore (Terra SG) to encourage Clementians to create positive social & environmental changes for the world we live in. Terra SG is an environmental social enterprise offering eco-education, upcycling workshops, team building programmes for schools and institutions.

This year, Clementians will be making their own Children's Day gift - an upcycled face mask holder made out of used juice / milk carton!

Clementians are required to bring the following items for the upcycling activity on Friday, 5 November:

1.	1 litre milk / juice carton (washed)	5.	a 30 cm ruler
2.	a pair of scissors	6.	a pen / pencil
3.	2 ice-cream sticks	7.	a ten-cent coin
4.	a rubber band

As Clementians are allowed to come to school dressed in going out clothes and covered shoes, we would like Clementians to explore what upcycling is about and **create an upcycled accessory by reusing discarded objects or materials, to be worn on <b>Friday, 12 November!** Exciting prizes will be up for grabs!
























- · Clothes with offensive words are not allowed.





